- Summarizing the document...

 - Even though a senior may have fulfilled the graduation requirements (required classes and number of credits), if it is determined that the student has not made a conscientious effort to pass, the senior may be excluded from senior activities and/or the commencement ceremony.

- Summarizing the document...
 - ATTENDANCE -
 - Attendance patterns and reasons for absences will be carefully studied. The general rule is for 90% attendance during Senior Year.
 - The administration will review all instances of senior truancy (cuts)
 during the last few months of school. Cutting classes whether for a
 single block or full day may result in the exclusion from activities
 - The senior picnic is provided as an activity day for seniors. Any senior participating in planning or conducting a <u>senior cut day</u> will face serious disciplinary action and removal from senior activities and/or the commencement ceremony.

 - ATTENDANCE -
 - Attendance and punctuality at the commencement practice is mandatory. Any student who misses commencement practice will not be allowed to participate in the commencement ceremony.

- Summarizing the document...
 - CONDUCT / CITIZENSHIP -
 - Taking away senior activities can and will be used as part of discipline for Seniors during the last few months for serious offenses. (Sr. Pranks too)
 - All detentions must be cleared before the specific activity.
