

Seniors 2018 Important Dates

August 7th - Senior school ID pictures and school fees (ASB, AP tests, PE clothes, etc.) day 8am-12pm in the WHS cafeteria. Senior Parking Paint Day 1-5pm.

August 10th - General parking Permit Sales 1-3pm. Students must have valid Driver License and Student ID card. Permits are free with ASB card or \$15 without. Parking is very limited and not all students will be able to purchase a parking permit.

September 18th - Senior Parent Meeting 6-8pm in the WHS Theater. This meeting covers graduation requirements as well as provides an opportunity to hear from our graduation vendors to take advantage of early bird pricing on items such as yearbooks, cap and gowns, sober grad night, senior grad trips, and more.

September 27th - Grad products rep. on campus during lunch and in the evening for cap and gown, class ring and announcement orders

November 17th - Cap and Gown Orders due. Order forms can be turned into the student store or placed directly through <http://www.premiergradproducts.com/>.

April 17th to 20th - Senior Ball Ticket Sales. Tickets will be \$65 with an ASB card, \$70 with a student ID, and \$75 for a guest. You will be able to purchase your tickets during lunch and after school **ONLY** at the student store. You must have the senior ball contract completed, guest pass (if bringing a non-Whitney student), a detention clearance stamp, and ID card in order to purchase a ticket.

**completed guest passes must be turned into Mrs. Cano in the front office no later than Friday, April 13th in order to be approved.*

May 15th to 18th – Senior Activities ticket sales (Senior Picnic and Breakfast)

The Senior Picnic and Breakfast are sold as a combination package. The price is \$40 to attend both events. Tickets are sold this week and this week only. In order to purchase a ticket you must turn in a completed permission slip which will be handed out in government classes the week of May 1st-5th and is online at whs.rocklinusd.org under the Activities tab or picked up from the Student Store and have all detentions cleared. There will not be any refunds for these tickets.

May 23rd – Panoramic Picture @ 9:15 am

Seniors will report to the outdoor basketball courts. All seniors will be in the picture and graduation gowns (only) will be worn. Order forms will be made available in the student store the week prior and again the morning of the picture.

June 1nd – Senior Semester Grades are Submitted & Eligibility List is Finalized

Any senior wishing to participate in senior week activities must pass all classes required for graduation by this date or be considered ineligible for all senior activities. There will not be any refunds for these tickets.

2018 Senior Week – June 4th to June 7th

Seniors will be required to be in attendance each day, either with their teachers on campus, in the school cafeteria, or with the senior class at the organized senior class activities.

Monday, June 4th @ 7:45 am – Graduation Practice #1

Mandatory graduation practice will occur. During this practice you will be put in your rows, fill out your name cards, and complete your picture cards. Roll will be taken.

Tuesday, June 5th @ 7:45 am – Graduation Practice #2

During this time the seniors will go through the checkout process. You must go through this process to receive your diploma.

Tuesday, June 5th @ 9:30 am – Senior Picnic

Immediately following the checkout process all participating seniors will be transported to Beals Point at Folsom Lake for a picnic. No personal driving is allowed. Music, food, sports, etc. will be provided. ***The student attending this event will have access to the lake in designated swimming areas. We have hired a team of trained and certified open water Lifeguards to ensure the safety of all students who choose to go into the water.***

Wednesday, June 6th @ 7:45 am – Graduation Practice #3

Graduation practice from 7:45 am until 9:30 am. All students will meet in the gym. Roll will be taken (if you are tardy, you will not be allowed to attend that day's senior activity) and your attendance is mandatory.

Wednesday, June 6th @ 10:00 am – Senior Breakfast

The senior breakfast will take place at Lincoln Hills Orchard Creek Ballroom. You must have purchased the senior activities tickets to attend this event. This is where the senior slide show will be viewed and the spoof awards will be given. Students will drive themselves and meet at Lincoln Hills no later than 10am.

Thursday, June 7th @ 7:45 am – Graduation Practice #4 (*Graduation Track tickets will be given to seniors at grad practice this day. Each student will receive **ONLY 2 track tickets, all other seating is general admission and no tickets are necessary*)**

This is the last practice before the ceremony. Roll will be taken and your attendance is mandatory. If you do not attend practice, you will not participate in the graduation ceremony.

Roll will be taken. You will get in your rows and we will take care of any last minute issues. Enjoy every last moment.
