SPEECH TREK CONTEST TOPIC FOR 2018-2019

TOPIC: HOW CAN WE ELIMINATE VIOLENCE AIMED AT OUR SCHOOLS?

Also, address the following questions:

*H*ow can we--students, parents, faculty, our communities, and organizations such as AAUW-eliminate violence aimed at our schools? What actions can we take to prevent another tragedy from taking place?

Background:

To guarantee equality, individual rights, and social justice in a diverse society, AAUW advocates many issues--including freedom from violence, fear of violence and hate crimes--in homes, schools, workplaces, and communities.

Unfortunately, American students are not free from violence. Sen. Dianne Feinstein (D-Calif) pointed out a disturbing trend in our schools: "Since Sandy Hook (Dec. 14, 2012), around 250 schools have experienced a shooting. That's an average of around 50 a year, or one school shooting every week," she said. "It's astonishing that so many schools and so many children have suffered. Active shooter drills shouldn't be a way of life for our children, but sadly they are."

Singer Kelly Clarkson has also expressed sadness at the escalating level of violence in our schools, and stated that the time for 'moments of silence' is over. "Why don't we do a moment of action?" she asked. "Why don't we do a moment of change?"

In February, 2018, after their tragedy, the students of Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida, seized a moment for change. They created "March For Our Lives" and launched a national movement.

Three months later, another deadly school shooting took place, this time in Texas.

CONTEST INFORMATION

Eligibility: The local Speech Trek competition is open to all actively attending high school students in South Placer County. The CA State Final is open to all California high school students who qualify to advance to State Final.

Application Deadline: Must be received by January 23, 2019

Time Limits: Students are to prepare an original 5:00-6:00 minute speech, with a 30-second grace period on either side. **Speaking under 4:30 or over 6:30 will result in disqualification.**

Presentation: These presentations are to be original speeches. Appropriate use of **one** 4" x 6" note card is an option--prompting is not allowed.

Judging: During the State Semi-Final and Final competition, judges shall use the official ballot and score each speaker in two areas: Content (includes Introduction, Organization and Conclusion), 0-50 points; and Delivery, 0-50 points. Branches may opt to use their own Judge's ballot at the local level. Students are advised to request a copy of their Branch's Judge's ballot.

Semi-final: Friday, February 8, 2019, 5:00 PM, Whitney High School, Rocklin, CA Local Final: Friday, February 15, 2019, 4:30 PM, Kilaga Springs Lodge, Lincoln, CA State Final: Saturday, April 6, 2019, Handlery Hotel, San Diego, CA (Travel, lodging, and meals reimbursed.)

Local Final Winner may qualify for State Final: AAUW Roseville-South Placer Branch will post the video of their winning speech online by March 1, 2019. The State Speech Trek judges will identify five finalists, two of whom will be named as Honorable Mention. The State Speech Trek judges will invite the top three finalists to compete for cash prizes at the AAUW CA State Convention/Annual Meeting on Saturday, April 6, 2019, at the Handlery Hotel in San Diego. Travel expenses, lodging, and meals for each finalist and her/his chaperone will be reimbursed by Speech Trek. Those expenses should not exceed approved budget.
