Up to \$12,240
Annually

- Student's Social Security card and drivers license (or government issued ID), if available
- Parent's Social Security card (if available)
- Parent's federal income tax return** from tax year 2015
- Records of untaxed income** such as child support, TANF, interest income, veterans non-education benefits, Social Security benefits
- Student's 2015 federal income tax return, or evidence of income earned (W-2 form or pay records)
- Bank account records or statements
- Records of stocks, bonds or investments
- Business records
- If not a US citizen, bring alien registration card (if available)
- A list of the colleges you are interested in

REMEMBER!

To qualify for a Cal Grant you must submit the FAFSA or Dream Act application and GPA verification no later than **March 2, 2017**. See your counselor to get a GPA verification.
