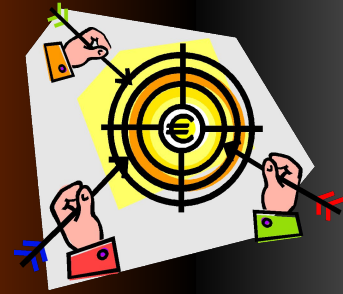

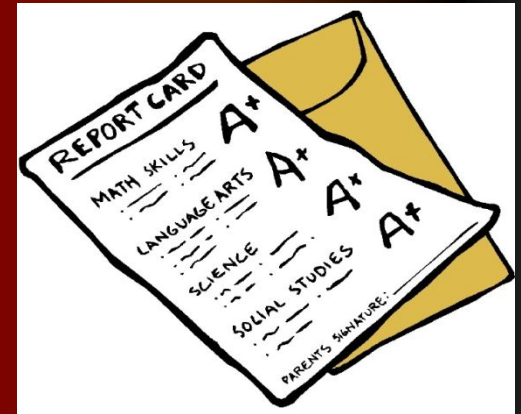

- **Mastery Learning of Essential Concepts**
 - No Mastery = No Credit
- **Summer School/Night School**
 - Remedial not Enrichment
 - Summer School – highest grade = C
 - College Prep
 - Night School – Jr/Sr – Last Resort
 - Not College Prep
