Sophomores took the PSAT on October 11, and their results will be available in December. We will meet with students to review their scores and to help them log onto My College QuickStart, which is a great resource provided by the College Board.

We encourage students to take the PSAT again in October of their Junior year since it provides more practice and determines if they're eligible for the National Merit Scholarship.

## **Graduation Requirements**
