

Graduation Requirements

- Earn 250 Credits
- Pass Required Classes
 - 4 years English
 - 3 years Math
 - 3 years Science
 - 1 year VAPA
 - 3.5 yrs Social Studies
 - 1 year Foreign Language
 - 1 year Technology
 - 3 years PE
- Complete 25 hours of Community Service
 - Completed by end of junior year

Community Service

- 25 hours required for graduation
 - Non-profit agency or organization
 - Pre-approval from counselor/advisor or College & Career Center
 - Opportunities and contracts available in the College & Career Center
 - Hours should be completed by the end of the Junior Year
 - 150 = Distinguished Community Service






Summer School


-

Night School


-

 - Applications are picked up and returned in the Counseling Center
 - Night school courses meet graduation requirements, but do not meet college entrance requirements



Graduation vs. College Eligibility





Satisfying Whitney High graduation requirements does not mean you have met college eligibility requirements.

- 2 yrs Foreign Language
 - *3 recommended*
- 1 year VAPA





College Preparation AP/Honors Classes

- Requires serious approach to studies
 - Plan for AP prerequisites
 - Must complete Honors/AP Approval Form
 - Spread AP/Honors coursework over more than one year
 - \$93 Test fee required for AP Classes
 - AP/Honors Information Night



Distinguished Scholar

- Students must complete (12) AP/Honors offerings 5 being AP
- Have a 3.8 weighted GPA
- Have a 90% attendance rate
- No major disciplinary or attendance infractions
- A minimum of 150 community service hours
- A leadership course (list of approved leadership available on checklist)

■ January-March


-


■ April-May

- 





■ April



- UC/CSU Deadline for Intent to register – May 1


