The Butte County Sheriff held a press conference yesterday and said that this fire is now the deadliest in state history.

The county also lost over 7-thousand structures ... many of them were homes.

A representative from the Butte County Fairgrounds said they have a 5-thousand square foot building filled with clothes, stacked over five feet high.

Organizers now say they need money and gift cards to help victims of the fire.

Reporter Leah Deutch went to the Rocklin Police station to learn how you can help those effected by the fire.
