COLONEL MICHAEL A. FERNANDEZ (Retired from AF 1 Feb 2011)



Colonel Michael A. Fernandez is the Director of Operations, 618th Tanker Airlift Control Center, Scott AFB, Illinois, As the Director of Operations, Colonel Fernandez provides leadership and direction for the 18th Air Force Commander's Air Operations Center providing command and control of over 900 missions per day, around the clock, 365 days per year. Missions include tanker, airlift, aeromedical, Presidential and special operations. Colonel Fernandez personally supervised Air Mobility Command's crisis response involving relief efforts supporting the Haitian earthquake, Icelandic volcano eruption, Gulf oil spill, Chilean earthquake, and the Presidential order of 30,000 additional troop buildup to Afghanistan. Colonel Fernandez is a Master Navigator with more than 2,200 hours of flight time, including 126 hours of combat time, primarily in KC-135 aircraft. After completing Air Force navigator training at Mather AFB CA, he served flying tours at Grissom AFB IN, Castle AFB CA, Scott AFB IL, and MacDill AFB, FL. During his aviation service, Colonel Fernandez has served as an Operations Group Deputy Commander.

Expeditionary Ops Group Deputy Commander at Manas Air Base, Republic of Kyrgyzstan during Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and IRAQI FREEDOM, Operations Officer during Operation DENY FLIGHT and Operation ALLIED FORCE, deployed aircrew member during Operation DESERT SHIELD, Howard Tanker Task Force Assistant Operations Officer, Republic of Panama, and as an Operations Support Squadron Commander. His staff assignments include two tours at Headquarters Air Mobility Command and the standup of the initial cadre for the Tanker Airlift Control Center. Colonel Fernandez' academic credits include two master's degrees and he is a resident graduate of all three Air Force Professional Military Education schools; Squadron Officer School (SOS), Air Command and Staff College (ACSC), and Air War College (AWC). Colonel Fernandez is a 1982 graduate of California State University, Sacramento and is married to the former Cindy Dyer of Rancho Cordova, CA.
