Ground Rules for Peer Review

- Be Respectful - remember that you are reading someone else's writing - DON'T make fun of it
- Only make constructive comments that will help improve the writing
- Please take this seriously and read carefully
- Fill out the rubrics accurately - Be Honest not Easy



Writing Review - Step 1: Self Assessment

- Put your name on the grade sheet
- Carefully read your two paragraphs
- Fill out the "Self Assessment" for paragraph 1 and 2
- Staple the grade sheets to your paragraphs and hand them in to the teacher



Steps: Peer Review

- Hand your work and rubrics to another student
- Carefully read paragraph 1 ONLY
- Highlight or underline the following as you find it in their writing
 - Citations
 - Atoms involved
 - Importances of bonds
 - Molecules and their function
 - Where the atoms came from
- You may also write suggestions and make grammar corrections as you see the need
- Write your name in the the space for "reviewer name"
- Fill out the rubric for Peer Review #1 ONLY
- Hand the papers to someone else for Paragraph 1
- when you get a paper that has all of paragraph 1 graded, please begin with paragraph 2
- When you are the second grading paragraph two, return it to the owner
