Doyle Scholarship

Amount Awarded: \$1,200

Deadline: **03/02/2021**

This scholarship is for high school graduates who are planning to enroll at the Santa Rosa Junior College as first-time students.

Amount Awarded: \$3,000 - \$6,000

Deadline: 02/15/2021

Burlington North Santa Fe Foundation Scholarship

Amount Awarded: \$2,500 - \$10,000

Deadline: 03/31/2021

This scholarship is made available to American Indian high school seniors with a 3.0 GPA or higher, who reside in one of the 13 states serviced by the Burlington Northern and Santa Fe Pacific Corporation, and its affiliated companies.

Note: Recipients must maintain a 2.75 GPA their freshman and sophomore years, and a 3.0 GPA their junior and senior years to receive scholarships for all four years. (\$2,500 per academic year, up to 4 years).

Amount Awarded: **\$500** Deadline: **04/30/2021**
