Professional BusinessWomen of California (PBWC) Scholarship Up to \$15,000 | 01/31/21

This scholarship is open to female California high school seniors, who will be enrolling in an undergraduate academic program at an accredited college or university with the United States.

The California Teachers Association Scholarships Up to \$5,000 | 01/29/21

These scholarships are open to CTA members, dependent children of active members, and Student CTA members.

Northern California counties: Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Merced, Monterey, Napa, Sacramento, San Benito, San Francisco, San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, Stanislaus or Yolo.

Southern California counties: Los Angeles, Orange or San Diego.

Students who are pursuing health careers (i.e. physician, nurse, pharmacist, dentist, etc.) are not eligible to apply.
