- New Community Service Recording Process
- **Community Service Update:** Effective immediately, students will no longer report their community service hours into Service Learning in Aeries.
- The new Community Service process is as follows:
 - Visit the Whitney High School Counseling webpage and select the "Community Service" option.
 - Fill out the form if you have fulfilled 25 hours for the graduation requirement or 150 hours for the Distinguished Community Service Requirement.
 - We recommend that students document their hours in the Record of My WHS Community Service 9th through 12th grade.
 - This is important as the document shows proof of completing 25 hours of community service and will be required to show proof of completing 150 hours for the Distinguished Community Service Award.

 We understand that adjusting to this new process may take some time, and our school counselors will be discussing community service requirements in all future presentations to ensure students are well-informed. Thank you for your cooperation and commitment to community service.
